Northern Star School in Sapporo : "An advance step educationally has been taken by preparing curricula for two years above the present course in three departments : Religious Education, English, and Domestic Science."

In each of the five mission high schools, religious education, chiefly Bible study, is part of the regular work required of each pupil throughout her entire course. Once or twice each year. [*sic*] either by special meetings, by outside evangelists, by individual or group conferences conducted by well qualified regular teachers an opportunity is given the older girls to make a personal dedication of their lives to Christ. These girls are encouraged, also to make public their decision by becoming active members of the churches. The five schools report 120 girls as having been baptized and many

others as having expressed a desire to be baptized as soon as permitted by their parents.
