The land, 180 Tsubo, is leased free of rent for twelve years, and the Mission holds a paper to that effect. The eight hundred yen lent to the school by the Mission (1894) to be returned at the end of that period unless other arrangements are made which shall be satisfactory to the Mission and School property trustees. The Mission house on said property belongs exclusively to the Mission. The tenth anniversary of our school was celebrated this year on the 6th of July. A Japanese dinner was served to twenty-seven guests, mostly former graduates and teachers. In the afternoon a literary entertainment was given which included readings, essays, recitations a dialogue, music and speeches. Former graduates and pupils were fairly well represented.
