And from Sapporo Miss Monk writes :

“ Our two new teachers, who are fitting into the work beautifully, are the only two of this year's graduates at Joshi Gakuin who have undertaken any kind of work. So, especially considering the great lack of qualified teachers, we feel most happy in securing them.”

At Hokusei Jo Gakko, the Sapporo school, among the 175 enrolled 55 are Christians. Nineteen were baptized last year, and the Government inspectors were greatly pleased with the management, light, ventilation and instruction.
