Dear friend:

I am well, and, as I am remaining in Sapporo this summer, am very busy with the work which I have no opportunity for during the year. The ground is broken and foundation laid for the two new buildings on the new school lot; and religious services are held for the workmen (and others) twice a week during the noon hour. I heard sixty (60) were present yesterday.

I am now attending evening services in the East and South suburbs, twice in the week. This I can not do while having my children's meetings, not having the strength. I have also had the pleasure of entertaining, for a few days each, two invalids----one a foreigner, one a Japanese.

Remember our suburban work: our chapel: our Free Dispensary (just starting). We all need your prayers.
